Looking Forward to Meeting WCPA Members!

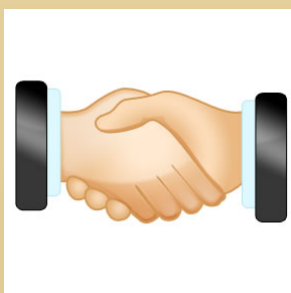

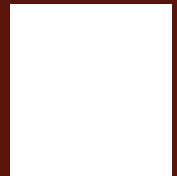
